Interested in pursuing one of our exciting 2+2 pathways?

2+2 Indigenous Studies

Study 2 years at Mohawk + 2 years at McMaster or Laurier (in Indigenous Studies) and earn three credentials: GAS diploma (Program 208) + Indigenous Ways of Knowing Certificate (Program 338) + Honours BA in Indigenous Studies (from McMaster* or Laurier). To be eligible, you must take all eight of our Indigenous Studies courses and earn a minimum GPA of 75%.

2+2 Human Rights & Human Diversity (HRHD) at Laurier University

Study 2 years at Mohawk + 2 years at Laurier and earn two credentials: GAS diploma (Program 208) + Honours BA in HRHD. To be eligible you must take Introduction to Sociology, Your Voice Matters (previously called Introduction to Government), Introduction to Applied Research plus eight key courses (*options) and earn a minimum GPA of 75%.

*Other majors, double majors and major/minor options may also be available after admission to McMaster, subject to program requirements.

Interested in studying Humanities & Social Sciences at university?

Brock University

Earn a minimum GPA of 70% and be eligible to receive up to six units of transfer credit (one year is equivalent to five units).

McMaster University

Earn a minimum GPA of 75% and be eligible to receive up to 48 units of transfer credit (equivalent to ~ 1.5 academic years).

Laurier University

(Brantford or Waterloo campus) Earn a minimum GPA of 75% and be eligible to receive up to six units of transfer credit (one year is equivalent to five units).
