OSAP

The Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) is a federally and provincially sponsored grant and loan program for eligible students. Fill out the online or paper application as a full-time or part-time student and OSAP will consider you for eligible loan and grant programs. There is no fee to apply for OSAP. Apply for OSAP at **ontario.ca/osap**

Pay your fees and secure your spot

To secure your seat and avoid late fees, make your payments by all published due dates using any of the following payment methods. Fees must be received at Mohawk before online course registration can take place.

Payment options

Non-OSAP Students

Pay the non-refundable tuition deposit of \$500 on time to secure your seat.
Pay the total amount owing by the due date indicated on the Fee Statement to select your timetable to register.

Receipt of your sponsorship letter by the tuition deposit deadline on your Fee Statement will secure your seat in the program and enable you to choose your timetable during the registration period.

OSAP Students

Pay the non-refundable tuition deposit of \$500 on time to secure your seat. Before you can register and select a timetable, we need confirmation that your OSAP application has been received by the Ministry. The balance of fees are due by the deferral due date.

You will be required to pay the balance of your fees at timetable selection if you do not have a valid OSAP application.

Payment methods

Fee Statements will be sent by mail and emailed to your MOCOmotion email account.

Tuition fees may be paid:

1. Online

Using your Mohawk username and password (sent by mail to all new applicants), login to our student portal at moco.mohawkcollege.ca

2. Electronic Banking

Use your SBID number (on your Fee Statement) to pay your fees in person or online through your banking institution. Allow 3–5 business days for processing.

3. Mail

Send a certified cheque, money order or credit card number (VISA or MasterCard with expiry date and signature) with the bottom portion of your Fee Statement. Please do not send cash through the mail.

4. In-person

Bring your Fee Statement and pay with cash, certified cheque, debit card, MasterCard, or VISA to The Square at any campus.
